## Code of Conduct



Library users are expected to behave in a manner that allows the library to be a pleasant place to visit for everyone. All library visitors are expected to:

- 1. Show respect for all library users, staff, furnishings, and materials.
- 2. Refrain from harassing anyone or impeding the use of the library by others.
- 3. Keep voices low and language civil.
- 4. Properly check out library materials and follow other circulation guidelines.
- 5. Refrain from using the library as a place to sleep.
- 6. Refrain from boisterous conduct, running, throwing items, or other conduct which could endanger anyone.
- 7. Keep entrances, doorways, and stairs (both inside and outside) clear for other people.
- 8. Use the furniture and other facilities in an appropriate manner.
- 9. Refrain from gathering in large groups, as the resulting noise and behaviors easily become disturbing to other library users.
- 10. Refrain from using tobacco on library property.
- 11. Refrain from bringing beverages or food into the library.
- 12. Refrain from using skateboards, scooters or in-line skates on library property.
- 13. Use cell phones only in lobby area to avoid disturbing other library users
- 14. Utilize earphones at a low volume on electronic devices while inside the library building.
- 15. Adhere to all Pioneerland Library System policies as well as local, state, and federal laws while utilizing library facilities and resources.

## Persons who choose to violate these rules may be asked to leave the library. Repeat offenders may have their library privileges suspended.
